Joan McLaughlin (Technical Director) is a freshman at UAB majoring in Art and Drama. She has worked with other productions at UAB.


Jackie Wilson (Assistant Stage Manager) is a senior at UAB majoring in English. This is his first time to work with Theatre UAB.
