

Director's Note:

In Scenes From an Execution, playwright Howard Barker's late 16th Century painter Galactia exclaims, "Artists have no power and great imagination. The state has no imagination and great power." It is this struggle between artistic and personal freedom and the demands of governing a modern state that are at the center of this provocative play. Many of the themes that Barker touches on could have been drawn from our own current political debate. As the Admiral of the Navy tells Galactia, she is "afraid to be sucked down into the well of a different truth" but Galactia is determined to remain true to her goal to "shatter tolerance." Barker exposes that truth is defined by an individual's perspective and attempting to find simple answers to complex issues always leads to simplification.
