

Notes on this production:

When in 1987 lyricist-composer Stephen Sondheim and librettist James Lapine attempted a follow-up to their previous Pulitzer Prize-winning production, Sunday in the Park with George, the world around them was at a crossroads. While America had developed into an international military powerhouse, the HIV and AIDS epidemic ravaged its marginalized communities. With these two events coinciding, a newfound national question emerged into the zeitgeist: is a nation aware of its own limits? For their new musical, Into the Woods, Sondheim and Lapine decided to revisit and critically reinterpret classical fairytales—those of the Brothers Grimm, which similarly intertwined with the idea of national unity a century before.

When the Brothers Grimm sought to compile authentic folklore in the nineteenth century, it was under the guise of patriotism and a way to tell the story of those who made up the backbone of Germany: the farmers and the common folk. The movements their work was part of are known as German Romanticism, Industrial Revolution, and Modernism. While the Brothers Grimm were deemed delineators traveling the countryside at the time, their scholarly endeavor has been disputed by historical reports, suggesting a more complicated truth. One has them recontextualizing already established tales in the comforts of wealth rather than a German farmer's dinner table. These fairytales, though, served as excellent fodder for the campaign, quickly becoming a dominating symbol of German national identity. In the late 1980s, a concept of American national identity seemed far more apparent yet impossible to articulate as it was everywhere. *Into the Woods* responds to that post-modern perception by reflecting on the country's social fragmentation, cultural diversification, and moral self-questioning.

Into the Woods grapples with ideas such as community, generational trauma, and uncertainty of the future. By using such a familiar framework, Sondheim and Lapine could stretch the consequences of selfish transgressions in the face of uncertainty. Sondheim intended for the Giant and the Woods to be symbols of the unconscious: placeholders for the plethora of events occurring in the world at the time. He felt that fairytales would never feel dated and, thus, the threat be timeless. In Sondheim's own words, the Woods are "the dark place where we face our trials and emerge wiser or destroyed." Director Valerie Accetta wanted to further explore the Woods' boundaries as Sondheim imagined. We are once again at a historical crossroads, like in Sondheim's time and even that of the Brothers Grimm. We have been thrust into the woods, and like those before, finding a way out has never been so necessary for hope to exist just beyond the pines.
