Prospective students should NOT begin any coursework without first seeking advisement from the program faculty advisor (call 205-934-5371). Students who ignore this admonition assume responsibility for their own mistakes.			
In addition to meeting the requirements for admission to the Graduate School, a candidate must meet requirements for unconditional admission to the Collaborative Special Education (6-12) Program. To be eligible for unconditional admission to this Class A certification program, a candidate must hold a valid Alabama bachelor's level Professional Educator Certificate in Collaborative Special Education (6-12) or a valid Alabama bachelor's level Professional Educator Certificate in any teaching field.			
Please Note: If an individual is unconditionally admitted to this Class A program based on a valid bachelor's level professional educator certification from another state, this individual must hold valid Alabama Class B Professional Educator Certificate before completing this Class A program and subsequently applying for Alabama certification at the Class A level in Collaborative Special Education (6-12).
