ALSDE Requirements for Class AA Certification in Physical Education (P-12)

Once a candidate has completed checklist requirements and has met all admission, exit, and certification requirements, the candidate will be eligible for Class AA certification in Physical Education (P-12). To be eligible for this certification, the candidate must:

- submit a completed application for certification during the last term of enrollment in the Class AA Physical Education (P-12) Program (and no later than 60 calendar months following completion of this degree program)
- successfully complete all courses on the Class AA program checklist, meet the criteria of UAB's Graduate School for completing the corresponding Educational Specialist degree program, earning an overall GPA of 3.50
- possess a valid Class A Professional Educator Certificate in the Physical Education (P-12) Program or Class B in Physical Education (P-12) and Class A in ESOL (P-12); and
- meet all requirements for the Alabama Educator Certification Assessment Program (AECAP)

Program Admission Requirements for Class AA Certification in Physical Education (P-12)

Prospective students should NOT begin any coursework without first seeking advisement from the program faculty advisor (call 205-934-5371). Students who ignore this admonition assume responsibility for their own mistakes.

In addition to meeting the requirements for admission to the Graduate School, a candidate must meet requirements for unconditional admission to the Physical Education (P-12) Program. To be eligible for unconditional admission to this Class AA certification program, a candidate must hold a **valid** Alabama master's level professional educator certificate in Physical Education (P-12) (or else Class B in Physical Education (P-12) and Class A in ESOL (P-12).

Please Note: If an individual is unconditionally admitted to this Class AA program based on a valid bachelor's level professional educator certification from another state, this individual must hold valid Alabama Class A certification in Physical Education (P-12) before completing this Class AA program in Physical Education (P-12) and subsequently applying for Alabama certification at the Class AA level in Physical Education (P-12).
