ALSDE Requirements for Alternative Class A Certification in Visual Arts (P-12):

Once a candidate has completed checklist requirements and has met all admission, exit, and certification requirements, the candidate will be eligible for Alternative Class A certification in Visual Arts (P-12). To be eligible for this certification, the candidate must:

- submit a completed application for certification during the last term of enrollment in the Alternative Class A certification in Visual Arts (P-12) Program (and no later than 60 calendar months following completion of this degree program)
- obtain a passing score on the Praxis test in Visual Arts
- successfully complete all courses on the Alternative Class A program checklist, meet the criteria of UAB's Graduate School for completing the corresponding master's degree program, earning an overall GPA of 3.25
- meet all requirements for the Alabama Educator Certification Assessment Program (AECAP)

Program Admission Requirements to the Alternative Class A Certification Program in Visual Arts (P-12)

Prospective students should NOT begin any coursework without first seeking advisement from the program faculty advisor (call 205-934-5371). Students who ignore this admonition assume responsibility for their own mistakes.

For unconditional admission to the Alternative Class A Certification in Visual Arts (P-12), candidates must:

- 1) have a passing score on the Visual Arts Praxis test;
- 2) have an unrounded cumulative 2.50 GPA on a bachelor's degree transcript (or 3.0 on master's degree transcript) from a regionally accredited institution and a suitable background clearance; and
- 3) meet any other criteria as required by the UAB Graduate School.
