Beginning with the Financial Analyst role, professionals engage in complex financial analysis, data interpretation, and methodology development to address senior administrators' inquiries. Analysts review financial reports, assess assumptions, and serve as key resources for various departments, ensuring analytical rigor and informed decision-making. Advancing to the Senior Financial Analyst, individuals take on broader responsibilities in financial informatics, data mining, and system automation, leveraging advanced tools and methodologies to optimize business processes and enhance reporting structures.

This career ladder fosters the development of specialized analytical expertise, equipping financial professionals with the ability to navigate complex datasets, support institutional projects, and drive financial decision-making across UAB.

Financial Analyst

The Financial Analyst role conducts and documents complex financial analysis and is responsible for interpretation of requests for analysis; developing methodologies to prepare analyses to address specific questions, concerns and requests for information presented by senior administrators; determining appropriate assumptions and explaining why they are appropriate. Financial Analysts are responsible for reviewing analysis prepared by other units, identifying strengths and weaknesses of information, determining whether assumptions used are appropriate, and effectively communicating concerns to preparing unit. Using senior level financial skills, Financial Analysts serve as a resource to other units in preparation of analysis; coordinate special financial projects as needed; and identify, obtain and assemble information from other units or departments in order to complete the project.
