MEASLES

With measles cases reappearing, know what signs and symptoms to look for and how contagious it is.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

Fever

Runny nose

Red eyes

Cough

Rash

Within 3 days of infection, a red rash appears, starting on the head and spreading down the body. People are contagious 4 days before and 4 days after the measles rash appears.



Virus can live in air nearly 2 hours

Highly contagious and spreads through the air when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

If one person has measles, 9 out of 10 people will also become infected if they are not vaccinated.
