Before serving in those roles, Caroline completed an Administrative Fellowship at Duke University Medical Center.

She also completed her Master of Science in Health Administration from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Caroline is a Fellow in the Carol Emmott Foundation, an organization focused on accelerating the leadership capacity and impact of women leaders in health. Caroline also serves as President of the University of Alabama at Birmingham's School of Health Professions Women in Healthcare Leadership Executive Board, and serves on the Board for We Care Jacksonville, a non-profit focused on providing access to specialty health care for low-income and uninsured patients.
